A visit to the places of Christianity, to discover the special relationship between Rome and the Pope. From the Vatican to the major basilicas, we will encounter works of art, symbols and monuments that tell the millennial history of this institution.

DAY 2 - VATICAN MUSEUMS

Breakfast at the hotel, meet with the guide and transfer to the Vatican State. The morning will be dedicate to discovering the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica.

There is a varied collection of artworks in the Vatican museums that span from ancient to contemporary times. Sarcophagi and mosaics share the space with masterpieces by great masters such as Giotto, Michelangelo, Leonardo Da Vinci, Raphael to Dalì, Canova and Matisse. In the midst of so much beauty, the presence of a fragment of lunar rock donated to Vatican citizens by the former US president Nixon continues to amaze.

DAY 3 - PAPAL BASILICAS

Breakfast at the hotel, meet with the guide for a morning dedicated to visiting the four Papal Basilicas and their masterpieces. We will tell the story, the traditions and the special privileges they enjoy, admiring the precious masterpieces inside. DAY 4 - FRASCATI AND WINE TOUR

Breakfast, check-out and transfer to Frascati. Meet with the guide for the tour. We will stroll through the streets of one of the most renowned municipalities of the Roman Castles, famous for the various Tuscolan villas, once home to illustrious patrician families. The town is also known for the cathedral of St. Peter in neo-Renaissance baroque style and the church of Jesus "Gesù" built in the eighteenth century by the genius of Carlo Fontana.

In the late morning we will move to a local winery. With a visit the old farmhouse surrounded by nature, vineyards and olive groves. In this area vines have been cultivated since Roman times, it is possible to visit ancient caves where wine has been aged for millennia. We will talk about the techniques of working the vine and the winemaking processes. Time to taste the famous Frascati wine! We will guide you through a tasting of three locally produced wines, including the famous white wine Frascati Superiore DOCG. To following lunch will be served, consisting of an appetizer and a first course of the Roman tradition.

At the end of the visit, transfer to the 4* hotel and accommodation in the assigned rooms. Afternoon at leisure, overnight stay.

EXTENTION 2 NIGHTS

At the end of the tour, continue to Ariccia where we can admire the buildings that overlook Piazza di Corte designed by Gian Lorenzo Bernini together with the Collegiate Church of Santa Maria Assunta, Palazzo Chigi (outside) and the famous Ariccia bridge. The majesty of the place and the natural beauty that surrounds it have made it a destination of the Grand Tour.

Return to Frascati, afternoon at leisure.

OPTIONAL* NEMI AND THE MUSEUM OF ROMAN SHIPS

Optional activity for the afternoon. Continue to the ancient village of Nemi, the smallest town in the Roman Castles, dating back to Roman times. Colorful, surrounded by nature and with a unique view of the lake of the same name, it offers noteworthy views of the surrounding landscape.

You can complete the day with a visit to the Museum of Roman Ships. Inside there are two 1/5 scale reconstructions of Caligula's ships recovered in an archaeological venture conducted from 1928 to 1932 in Lake Nemi. The original ships were lost in a fire in 1944, but in the museum there are many artifacts that survived the flames, in addition to what was found in the nearby Sanctuary of Diana. Not far from the Vatican stands Castel Sant'Angelo, built by order of the Emperor Hadrian wanting a much larger reproduction of the mausoleum of Augustus. Its intended use changed several times over the centuries, passing from bulwark to prison. The presence of the "Passetto" is singular, a pedestrian passageway that connects the site with the Vatican used by the pope to escape in case of danger. Includes entrance fee, guide. Price: 40€ per person

DAY 4 - ROME - FRASCATI

Breakfast at the hotel, check-out and luggage storage in the luggage room. Meet with the guide for a visit of "Renaissance and Baroque" Rome. We will start from Piazza di Spagna with the "Barcaccia" fountain and the "Spanish Steps". Along the characteristic streets of the center of Rome, we will arrive in front of the Trevi Fountain and then onto the Pantheon, built in 27 BC. Visit of the interiors, including the marvelous Hall of the Svizzeri, the splendid Garden of the Girandola, the majestic Portico of Vasanzio and the Theatre of the Acque. Continue to Grottaferrata, an elegant town in the Roman Castles for a visit to the Greek Abbey of San Nilo. The Abbey was founded in 1004 and is currently the last of the Byzantine rite monasteries in Italy. Built on the foundations of an important Roman villa, it incorporates the so-called Grotta Ferrata (cryptaferrata): a sepulchral cell presumed to be the tomb of Tulliola, daughter of Cicero. Along the way you can admire the Farnese Chapel with frescoes by Domenichino and the icon of Mary with Child by Gian Lorenzo Bernini.

Return to Frascati, lunch free (not included). Afternoon at leisure for individual visits, overnight stay.

OPTIONAL* NEMI WALKING TOUR

After lunch, it is possible to continue with an afternoon walk through the streets of the ancient village of Nemi, the smallest town among the Roman Castles dating back to Roman times. 

Ancient Rome with Colosseum, Palatine Hill and Roman Forum

The archaeological wonders of Rome, symbol of the greatness of this ancient civilization. A tour to begin the discovery of the Eternal City, with skip-the-line tickets and professional guide. Optional visit to the historic center in the places made famous by fashion and cinema.

ITINERARY

Meet with the guide at the meeting point in the city center and start of the guided tour of one of the largest archaeological areas in the world. We will begin the tour with the entrance to the Flavian Amphitheater, better known as the Colosseum, one of the most visited monuments ever, an icon of the Capitoline city.

With the skip-the-line ticket included and our professional guide, we will cross the entrance gate to enter the arena where the gladiator fights took place. We will tell the story and the secrets of this fascinating place that could hold up to 50,000 spectators.

Although time and looting have caused some damage, much of the Colosseum's structure is still standing. With the guide we will visit the interior of this archaeological wonder dating back to 80 A.D, it will be like going back in time for a truly unique experience!

ROMAN FORUM

After the visit to the Colosseum, we will move on to the Roman Forum, the center of political and religious power in Ancient Rome. Crossing the Via Sacra, or the road that connected Piazza del Campidoglio to the Colosseum, we will see the archaeological monuments of this extraordinary place, such as the Arch of Titus, the Basilica of Maxentius and Constantine and the Curia Iulia, the building where the Senate met.

PALATINE

The last part of our tour in the history of Rome will be to the Palatine Hill, which is the hill with the oldest inhabited center, dating back to 1,000 BC. This area is home to some of the most important buildings built for Roman high society, such as the Domus Flavia, the House of Livia and even the House of Augustus, which is the residence of the emperor and preserves part of its original frescoes.

OPTIONAL AFTERNOON - HISTORICAL CENTER

It is possible to combine the visit of Ancient Rome with a walking tour of the historic center and the squares of Rome. After the lunch break (not included) we will continue towards Piazza della Rotonda to admire the Pantheon, a building born as a temple in 27 BC. and later converted into a basilica and the Renaissance fountain of 1575.

We will then arrive at Piazza di Spagna, a place where important monuments such as the Barcaccia fountain and the Spanish Steps blend in with the innovation of great Italian brands such as Gucci, Fendi, Valentino who have chosen this location for their unforgettable fashion shows. Adjacent to the square we find Via Condotti, known as the fashion district and shopping for all tourists arriving in the capital. Do not miss the stop at the Trevi Fountain, made unforgettable by Fellini in the famous scene of La Dolce Vita in which a very young Anita Ekberg invites Marcello Mastroianni into the water: "Marcello, come here!". The tour ends at Piazza Barberini and Via Veneto.

St. Peter and Vatican Museums

Visit the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica with an expert guide. A tour of the sacred places, between art and millenary secrets. You can customize the tour with a climb to the dome of St. Peter's or a walk to Castel Sant'Angelo.

ITINERARY

Join the guide at the meeting point in the Vatican area. The morning is dedicated to discovering the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. A tour of about 3 hours, with priority tickets that allow you to avoid long waiting times at the entrance.

VATICAN MUSEUMS

The first stop of our tour will be at the Vatican Museums, one of the most famous museums in the world with over 6 million visitors every year. The Vatican Museums were inaugurated in the sixteenth century and conserves a unique collection of ancient and modern art. The itinerary includes a visit to the Sistine Chapel and the papal apartments frescoed by Michelangelo and Raphael.

Various works are collected in the Vatican museums that span ancient and contemporary times: sarcophagi and mosaics share the space with masterpieces by great masters such as Giotto, Michelangelo, Leonardo Da Vinci, Raphael up to Dalì, Canova and Matisse. In the midst of so much beauty, the presence of a fragment of lunar rock donated to Vatican citizens by former American president Nixon continues to amaze.

SISTINE CHAPEL

The tour of the Vatican Museums ends in the Sistine Chapel where it is possible to admire the famous frescoes by Michelangelo that cover the vault and the back wall with the Last Judgment, as well as the marvelous walls decorated by some of the greatest Italian artists of the second half of the fifteenth century (Sandro Botticelli, Pietro Perugino, Pinturicchio, Domenico Ghirlandaio and others).

BASILICA OF SAINT PETER

Before leaving the Vatican, you cannot miss a visit to St. Peter's Basilica with Bernini's Colonnade that frames the Dome designed by Michelangelo. We will cross the large Square of St. Peter, admiring the magnificence of the Apostolic Palace with the window where the Pope looks out for the Angelus every Sunday.



The legacy of Raphael in Rome

A two-day tour for art lovers and the highest expression it had in the Renaissance period thanks to the genius of Raphael. The artist gave the city of Rome an incredible legacy that we will discover together with our professional guide.

DAY 1

Join the guide at the meeting point and start of the tour. Visit of the Vatican Museums with the so-called "Raphael's rooms". There are four rooms, the Room of Constantine, the Room of Heliodorus, the Room of the Segnatura, the Room of the Fire of the Borgo that were part of the apartment chosen by Julius II and his successors as their residence. They were frescoed by Raphael and his pupils between 1508 and 1524. We will continue to the Gallery of the Tapestries, realized by Raphael's students and commissioned by Pope Clement VII to decorate the Sistine Chapel. In the Picture Gallery it will be possible to admire other masterpieces by the artist such as The Transfiguration of Christ, The Coronation of the Virgin and The Madonna of Foligno.

The afternoon will be dedicate to visiting the Borghese Gallery. The museum contains a collection of classical antiquities, as well as the works of the most important Italian artists including three masterpieces by Raphael: Pala Baglioni, Portrait of a man and Lady with the Unicorn.

End of the tour and return individually to the hotel.

DAY 2

Meet with the guide, this morning is dedicated to Raphael's masterpieces of Baroque Rome. We will start from the Museum of Palazzo Barberini where La Fornarina is exhibited, the portrait of Margherita Luti, Raphael's mistress and muse. We will continue the tour with a visit to the Trevi Fountain and the church of Sant'Agostino, where you can admire the fresco The Prophet Isaiah. Finally, in the ancient and monumental Pantheon, we will visit the Tomb of Raphael surmounted by the Madonna del Sasso sculpted by Lorenzetto, a pupil of Raphael. Here it is possible to read the epitaph by Pietro Bembo which reads "Here lies Raphael, from whom mother nature feared defeat while he was alive; but now that he is dead he is afraid of dying ". On the right, a plaque commemorates Maria Bibbiena, the painter's fiance, while on the left a nineteenth-century bust of the artist, by Giuseppe Fabris (1833).

End of the tour, lunch (not included) and afternoon free for individual visits.

Torpignattara: How Bella is wine and urban art Garbatella?

A walking tour to discover the Roman suburbs made unique by urban art.

ITINERARY

Meet with the guide in Piazza Malatesta, easily accessible from Termini with the new metro C.

Here the urban trekking will begin, crossing the most colorful streets of Torpignattara. The neighborhood is one of the most multi-ethnic in the capital, its origins are very ancient, over the years it has experienced ups and downs and has recently been re-evaluated thanks to the commitment of its residents.

In recent years the spirit of the neighborhood has been expressing itself through urban redevelopment works, with the creation of murals with enormous dimensions and hypnotic shapes. During the visit it will be possible to admire and photograph the works of international artists such as David Daviù Vecchiato, Dulk, Etam Cru, discovering more than twenty murals that have a great social value. These creations try to collect the voices of the different communities that share the space.

We will pass through Nicola Verlato's Sistine Chapel and Carlo Atoche's newest masterpiece, The Temple of Migrant Cultures, built in January 2021.

The tour ends with the tasting of typical Lazio wines and local products in a famous restaurant in the neighborhood.

Authentic Capitoline life through a village that has become a symbol of the city.

ITINERARY

Meet with the guide in front of the metro B Garbatella, easily accessible and well connected to the center and start of the tour.

We will visit the neighborhood born in 1920 thanks to a project in which the most famous architects of the time tried their hand, they took inspiration from the English "garden city", wanting to recreate the ancient bond between man and nature.

The walk through the streets of the working class suburb will lead us to the first stone laid by King Vittorio Emanuele III and then transport us into the history of the neighborhood through the gardens, the drying racks, the squares and the low houses.

Among anecdotes and curiosities we will discover the salient features of the Roman Baroque, the Palladium Theater, the White hotel visited by Gandhi and Via delle Sette Chiese where Canova's sketches are kept. You cannot miss a visit to the famous bar of the television series "I Cesaroni" which made the district famous throughout Italy and to the various clubs and social centers that embody the true essence of the place.

The tour ends with the tasting of three Lazio wines and a platter of cold cuts and cheeses in a typical winery, accompanied by our sommelier guide.

VILLA ADRIANA

In the morning, visit to the splendid imperial residence built by Emperor Hadrian in the period from 118 to 128 A.D. The villa extended over an area of about 130 hectares and is considered the largest and most luxurious residence that has ever been built in Italy. The architecture was inspired by the beauties scattered throughout the Empire, the most famous places in the provinces of the empire were reproduced with their names.

With our guide we will visit this collection of imperial palaces, temples, theaters, spas and swimming pools, telling the story and the personalies of the time. Time free for lunch (not included).

VILLA D'ESTE


In the afternoon we will move to Villa d'Este, a Renaissance masterpiece. The villa was built by the will of Cardinal Ippolito d'Este appointed governor for life of Tivoli by Pope Julius III in 1550. The work was entrusted to the architect Pirro Ligorio who was assisted by the best artists of the time including Gian Lorenzo Bernini. In addition to the beautiful apartments, it is amazing what the genius of the artists involved were able to achieve by exploiting the wealth of water that the area was endowed with. Fountains, water features and gardens of unique beauty.

We will visit the apartments, then the gardens with the Vialone, the Grand Loggia, Diana's Cave, the Rotonda dei Cipressi, the Fishponds, the numerous monumental fountains. Return to Rome at the end of the tour.

Frascati food and wine tour from Rome

Daily excursion from Rome dedicated to art, good wine and authentic gastronomy. Visit of Frascati and Grottaferrata, walk in the vineyard, wine tasting and meet with the producer.

VISIT OF FRASCATI

Arrival in Frascati in the morning with your own vehicle or by train. Meet with the guide for a walk in the historic center of the city. In an hour and a half we will visit Frascati along the narrow streets surrounded by local craft shops and gastronomic activities. The town is famous for the various Tuscolan villas once home to illustrious patrician families and is often remembered also for the Neo-Renaissance Baroque-style basilica of San Pietro and the church of Gesù built in the eighteenth century by Carlo Fontana on commission of a group of Jesuits.



Later on in the morning we will move to a local winery. Visit the old farmhouse surrounded by nature, vineyards and olive groves. In these places vines have been cultivated since Roman times, it is possible to visit ancient caves where wine has been aged for millennia. Surrounded by centuries-old vines and olive groves, it will seem like walking inside a natural museum in a heavenly setting just a few steps from the city. We will talk about the vine working techniques and the winemaking processes.

Time to taste the famous Frascati wine! We will guide you through a tasting of three locally produced wines, including the famous white wine Frascati Superiore DOCG. There will also be extra virgin olive oil, another pride of this land, which with its harmonious and fruity taste gives an extra touch to the gastronomic wonders of the area.

After a lunch will be served consisting of an appetizer and a first course of the Roman tradition.

GROTTAFERRATA AND SAN NILO ABBEY

In the afternoon, transfer to Grottaferrata, an elegant town in the Roman Castles and visit of the Greek Abbey of San Nilo. The Abbey was founded in 1004 and is currently the last of the Byzantine rite monasteries present in Italy. Built on the foundations of an important Roman villa, it incorporates the so-called Grotta Ferrata (cryptaferrata): a sepulchral cell presumed to be the tomb of Tulliola, daughter of Cicero. Along the way you can admire the Farnese Chapel with frescoes by Domenichino and the icon of Mary with the Child by Gian Lorenzo Bernini.

End of the tour and return to Rome individually.



COOKING CLASS. LET'S LEARN HOW TO MAKE PASTA!

During the visit to the winery it is possible to organize a cooking course held by a professional chef. Participants are divided into work stations with everything you

need. The chef will give a lesson on how to prepare fresh pasta, typical of traditional Italian cuisine. We will learn how to prepare exquisite ravioli or fettuccine (or pizza on request) which will then be cooked and tasted together with excellent local wine.

Archaeological itineraries in the area of the Roman Castles

Beyond the borders of Rome, in the villages gathered between Lake Albano di Castel Gandolfo and Lake Nemi. A tour designed to get to know a territory rich in history, art and gastronomic traditions. Optional visit to the Museum of Roman Ships.

ITINERARY

Meet with the guide in Albano Laziale or at the station of Frascati and then transfer to Albano. During the morning we will follow an itinerary amid the archaeological remains present in the cities gathered between Lake Albano di Castel Gandolfo and Lake Nemi.

ALBANO LAZIALE

Visit of Albano Laziale, one of the fifteen centers included in the Regional Park of the Roman Castles. The guide will tell the story of this area with the mythical Latin capital Alba Longa, the Jupiter Laziale Sanctuary, the Parthian legion of the Roman army and its fortified camp.

Entrance included to the Cisternone, an ingenious system that in Roman times ensured water to the military camp. The position in the highest part of the camp and the presence of two aqueducts that constantly fed it quaranteed its safe functioning.

We will continue the visit with the ancient mausoleum of the Horatii and Curiazi, unique sepulchers in their architecture reminiscent of Etruscan cinerary urns of Volterra. Although, as the name suggests, it is traced back to the Horatii and Curiazi warriors, its construction only dates back to the 1st century B.C, six centuries after their famous fight.

ARICCIA AND NEMI

We terminate the visit of the city with a walk through the shopping streets, before continuing to Ariccia where we will take a short stop to admire the buildings that overlook Piazza di Corte designed by Gian Lorenzo Bernini together with the Collegiate Church of Santa Maria Assunta, Palazzo Chigi and the famous Ariccia bridge. Continue to the ancient village of Nemi, the smallest town among the Roman Castles dating back to Roman times. Colorful, surrounded by nature and with a unique view of the lake of the same name, it offers noteworthy landscape views. End of the tour.



OPTIONAL ACTIVITY: **MUSEUM OF ROMAN SHIPS**

In the afternoon it is possible to complete the tour with the entrance to the Museum of Roman Ships in Nemi. Inside there are two 1/5 scale reconstructions of Caligula's

ships recovered in an archaeological venture conducted from 1928 to 1932 in Lake Nemi. The original ships were lost in a fire in 1944, but the museum does not lack many artifacts from the ships, in addition to what was found in the nearby Sanctuary of Diana.

The Tuscolan Villas between the Renaissance and the Baroque

An itinerary between art and gastronomy in the Roman Castles. We will visit Frascati, Grottaferrata and the Tuscolan villas, once summer residences of the nobility today witnesses of the uniqueness and grandeur of this territory

FRASCATI

Meet with the guide in Frascati and start of the tour. We will walk through the streets of one of the most renowned towns of the Roman Castles famous for the various Tuscolan villas, once home to illustrious patrician families. The town is also often remembered for the cathedral of St. Peter in neo-Renaissance Baroque style and the church of Gesù built in the eighteenth century by the genius of Carlo Fontana, as well as for the traditional local culture linked to wine and various gastronomic products.

VILLA MONDRAGONE

Later in the morning, transfer to Villa Mondragone (entrance ticket included), the largest of the Tuscolan Villas. Building started in 1573 by Cardinal Altemps, Mondragone lives its period of maximum expansion between the Renaissance and the beginning of the Baroque. It was the summer residence of the popes until 1626 when the new Pope Urban VIII moved it to Castel Gandolfo. Visit of the interiors, including the wonderful Hall of the Svizzeri, the splendid Garden of the Girandola, the majestic Portico del Vasanzio and the Theatre of the Acque.

Before leaving Frascati for Grottaferrata we will talk about the history of Villa Aldobrandini which stands in the Roman Castles and dominates all of Rome. The centuries-old villa stands on a panoramic hill overlooking the entrance to the town and has seen powerful families often linked to the papacy within its walls.

VILLA GRAZIOLI

Lunch at Villa Grazioli (Grottaferrata) today transformed into a 5-star hotel with the prestigious Grazioli Art Bistrot restaurant. In the summer, you can have lunch outside on the exclusive terrace overlooking Rome.

Villa Grazioli is an ancient cardinal's villa located in a panoramic position on the Tusculum hill. We will visit the interior with the splendid frescoed rooms and the wonderful gardens overlooking Rome. The Villa is surrounded by a large centuries-old park, where guests can relax in contact with nature, in a context of peace and silence, away from the chaos of the city.

GROTTAFERRATA

After lunch, proceed to Grottaferrata, an elegant town in the Roman Castles. We will visit the Greek Abbey of San Nilo, founded in 1004 and is currently the last of the Byzantine rite monasteries in Italy. Built on the foundations of an important Roman villa, it incorporates the so-called Grotta Ferrata (cryptaferrata): a sepulchral cell presumed to be the tomb of Tulliola, daughter of Cicero. Along the way you can admire the Farnese Chapel with frescoes by Domenichino and the icon of Mary with Child by Gian Lorenzo Bernini. Return to Frascati and end of the tour.

From the Latin civilizations to the Middle Ages Excursion from Rome

The traces of a thousand years of history lived in one day: from the temples erected by the Latin civilizations, passing through Ancient Rome and the culture of wine up to the medieval period. Available as a day excursion from Rome or in two days.

PALESTRINA, THE TEMPLE OF PRAENESTE AND CASTEL SAN PIETRO ROMANO

Meet with the guide at the hotel in Rome, transfer to Palestrina. Visit of the town famous for the Sanctuary of Fortuna Primigenia, a sacred complex dedicated to the goddess of Luck, one of the greatest examples of late-republican architecture in ancient Italy.

We will visit the Colonna Barberini palace, seat of the Pre-Roman Archaeological Museum, an important museum that collects the finding from the Sanctuary as well as the wonderful Nile Mosaic, one of the most famous masterpieces of the Hellenistic period.

At the end of the visit we will take a break inside Palazzo Barberini. Included in the tour is the tasting and workshop on "Giglietti di Palestrina", biscuits made with simple ingredients that have their origins in history.

We will continue the tour with a walk to Castel San Pietro Romano, a set for many films after the Second World War.

FRASCATI AND WINE TASTING

Later in the morning, transfer to Frascati to visit a winery. After a walk through the vineyards, we will visit the cellar, explaining the grape processing techniques, barrel aging and combinations. Together with a sommelier we will have the opportunity to taste three locally produced wines, paired with a lunch consisting of an appetizer and a main course.

NEMI AND THE MUSEUM OF ROMAN SHIPS

In the afternoon, we continue the visit to the town of Nemi, the best known of the Roman Castles towns. Visit to the Museum of Roman Ships where we will be able to admire the two 1/5 scale reconstructions of Caligula's ships recovered in an archaeological enterprise conducted from 1928 to 1932 in Lake Nemi. The original ships were lost in a fire in 1944, but the museum does not lack many artifacts from the ships, in addition to what was found in the nearby Sanctuary of Diana.

At the end of the tour, we will move to the historic center and walk up the main street to the highest point with a beautiful view overlooking Lake Nemi. Transfer to Rocca di Papa.

ROCCA DI PAPA, THE MEDIEVAL ROCK AND MEDIEVAL DINNER

In the second part of the afternoon the itinerary continues to Rocca di Papa, gently lying on the slopes of Monte Cavo, at the top of which stood the Temple of Jupiter Laziale.

Visit of the Medieval Fortress, a natural bulwark of volcanic origin placed on top of the ancient village where a fortified castle was built around the year 1000, today an interesting archaeological site and panoramic point. Later, we will head towards the characteristic Hannibal Refuge, not far from the homonymous town, the fields of Hannibal. It will be the occasion with our expert guide to tell another story of Ancient Rome, before taking part in the medieval dinner. End of the tour and return to Rome.

We are in Velletri, an ancient center of the Roman Castles, rich in a great artistic and architectural heritage, as well as the seat of longlived enological and culinary traditions. Precisely for these reasons, Ugo Tognazzi, one of the most prominent actors of the last century, chose it as a home for himself and his family.

THE LA TOGNAZZA

The estate, which he renamed La Tognazza, has for years been the meeting place of his distinguished colleagues such as Marco Ferreri, Luciano Salce, Vittorio Gassman, Paolo Villaggio, Marcello Mastroianni, Federico Fellini and Alberto Sordi. A safe haven where to share a meal prepared entirely with zero kilometer products produced in his farm accompanied by excellent homemade wine.

THE VISIT

Tognazzi left us in 1990 but his philosophy of good food is well maintained by his heirs who have made the estate a cultural association that allows us to visit the Memorial House, also known as Casa Vecchia (the Old House), where it will be possible to walk through the spaces that accompanied the most intimate moments of the actor's daily life and inspired some of his screenplays such as The Big Feast or My Friends. We will attend the screening of a documentary on the actor, while our sommelier will present the products of the estate with a tasting of 3 wines accompanied by typical products. We will then continue to discover the rooms of the house, including the bedroom, the kitchen and the private spaces where the actor kept his fondest memories.



COOKING CLASS AND LUNCH

An optional experience that can be combined with the visit to the House Museum and wine tasting. It will allow us to relive the experience and the ferment that for years have been the protagonists of Tog-

nazzi's kitchen. A professional chef will teach us how to make excellent pasta, working in the same environment where the author gave life to his creations. An itinerary through Italy, stopping off in famous and evocative cities, home to art, culture and traditions, united by the priceless legacy left behind by the eclectic mind of Leonardo.

DAY 1 - ROME

Arrival in Rome, accommodation in the assigned rooms. Leonardo stayed here from 1514 to 1517, with the guide we will visit the symbolic places of the artist's passage in the capital. It was in Rome that Leonardo carried out important studies such as that of the Ustori Mirrors which had the purpose of conveying solar energy to heat the water, or the studies of anatomy and medicine carried out in his work at the Santo Spirito Hospital. We will visit the Vatican Picture Gallery where there is the painting of St. Jerome in penitence and a copy of Leda with the Swan kept in the Borghese Gallery. Another trace was left by Raphael in the Vatican Rooms by painting Leonardo in the role of Plato pointing his finger towards the sky alluding to the world of ideas.

Dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay.

DAY 2 - ANCHIANO - VINCI

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer from Rome to Anchiano (FI), the true birthplace of Leonardo, 3 km away from Vinci. We will visit the birthplace of the Genius now set up in a three-room museum where we will find a hologram of the artist that welcomes us by telling his story. The museum exhibits many of Leonardo's drawings made in his youth. This will be followed by a tour of the Vinci museum (Museo Leonardiano) where you can admire reconstructed models made to bring back to life the designs of the machines made by the artist. Lunch free (not included), transfer to Florence, dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay.

DAY 3 - FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel and visit of the symbolic places of Leonardo's studies and experiments. The artist arrived in Florence in 1469 starting his training in Verrocchio's workshop, where many of his works are still kept today. Due to his relationship with the Medici, lords of the city, Leonardo also devoted himself to engineering and warfare, as well as working as a sculptor and restorer in the St. Mark's Gardens. Many important works are preserved in the Uffizi Museum, including the Annunciation, the Adoration of the Magi, the Baptism of Christ. Lunch free (not included), in the afternoon the tour continues with the transfer from Florence to Venice. Dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay.

DAY 4 - VENICE

Breakfast at the hotel and visit to the artist's Venetian heritage. In Venice, Leonardo was commissioned to design defensive structures against the Turkish threat, inventing a system of locks on the Brenta capable of causing floods that should have hit the enemies on the mainland. Updated and revisited, the lock project is still in use today. We will also visit the Accademia Gallery where various drawings, caricatures and studies for important works are kept. The most famous drawing is The Vitruvian Man, but there are also the preparatory studies of the Virgin of the Rocks, the Last Supper, the Battle of Anghiari, the Virgin and Saint Anne and some grotesque caricatures from which local artists took inspiration. Lunch free (not included), in the late afternoon transfer to Milan. Dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay.


DAY 5 - MILAN

Breakfast at the hotel and tour of Milan with particular attention to the works left by Leonardo in the city. He arrived here in 1482 and immediately devoted himself to engineering, hydraulic and architectural studies, designing military machines and systems of locks and canals to navigate the city. In 1499 Leonardo left Milan to return for a second period ranging from 1508 to 1514. Leonardo's Milan conserves the Codex Atlanticus in the Ambrosian Library, many projects including that for the Dome of the Duomo and that for the Canals of the Navigli. In the Sforzesco Castle we find the Vegetable Weaves (painting that characterizes the Hall of Asse), the Trivulziano Code (a collection of drawings and writings), the drawings of the Old and Young Man and the Head of Leda. Traces of Leonardo's passage through the city are also present at the Brera Art Gallery where we can admire the Head of Christ and in the Ambrosiana Art Gallery where we find the Portrait of a Musician. A visit to the basilica of Santa Maria delle Grazie is a must, where some of the most famous works are kept, such as the Last Supper and the Portraits of the Dukes of Milan with their children. Dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay.

DAY 6 - END OF TOUR

Breakfast, end our services.









An itinerary to learn about the history and architectural beauties of Milan. We will then move to Lake Garda, with Sirmione and its millenary history. We will finish in two cities of the Veneto Region that are among the most beautiful and romantic in the world.

DAY 1 - START OF THE TOUR

Arrival and accommodation at the hotel.

DAY 2 - MILAN

In the morning, after breakfast at the hotel, meet with the guide. The visit of the city begins with a walking tour to discover the history, tradition and change of the city. We will take a walk from Piazza Scala to the Sforzesco Castle, passing through the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, the Duomo, Piazza Mercanti and Cordusio. Lunch free (not included). - Guided tour of the Grottoes of Catullus
- Guided tour of the Roman Villa.

DAY 4 - VERONA

After breakfast at the hotel, meet with the guide and tour of the city with an initial panoramic bus ride to see the New Renaissance and Palio Doors, the Castle and the Scaligero Bridge, the Arco dei Gavi, Porta Romana dei Borsari , Ponte Pietra and Roman Theater and then climb to the San Leonardo Hill to admire the panorama of the city. This will be followed by a walking tour in the historic center where it will be possible to admire Juliet's House, Piazza dei Signori, delle Erbe and Brà, Arche Scaligere and Arena. Lunch free (not included). Afternoon at leisure. Return to the hotel for overnight.

Afternoon optional activities (not included):

- Entrance inside the Arena.
- Typical Veronese dinner in a traditional restaurant.

DAY 5 - VERONA - VENICE

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Venice. Arrival and accommodation at the hotel. Meet with the guide in Piazzale Roma for a fantastic walking tour to St. Mark's Square passing through some characteristic corners of the city, with its ancient churches and palaces. We arrive at Ponte Rialto and then with a path that leads to St. Mark's Square, guided tour of the Basilica. Lunch free (not included).

Return to the hotel for overnight.

Afternoon optional activities (not included):

- Entrance ticket and guided tour of the St. Mark's Museum;
- Entrance ticket and guided tour of the Pala d'Oro,
- Entrance ticket and guided tour of the Treasury of St. Mark

DAY 6 - VENICE

- Gondola ride through the canals of Venice.

DAY 7 - END OF TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel, departure. End of our services.







Antiquity and the Middle Ages in the heart of Italy

A journey through the history of Italy, from antiquity to the Middle Ages. Villages and cities that through centuries of history, up to the Renaissance and the Baroque, are enriched with works of art and hidden treasures.

DAY 1 - ROME HISTORICAL CENTER

Arrival and accommodation at the hotel. In the afternoon we will commence with the visit of the Eternal City starting from the beautiful Piazza di Spagna and then the Trevi Fountain. We will continue to Piazza Colonna whose name comes from the presence of the Column of the Emperor Marcus Aurelius. On the way we will see the palaces of the Italian political power: Palazzo Chigi (Government), Palazzo di Montecitorio (Chamber of Deputies) and Palazzo Madama (Senate). After a short stop, visit to Piazza della Rotonda where you can see the Pantheon built by Emperor Hadrian in the second century A. C. and Piazza Navona with the magnificent Fountain of the Four Rivers by Bernini. We will end the visit with the Ara Pacis, an altar dedicated to peace by Emperor Augustus in the year 9 BC. Return to hotel, dinner and overnight.

DAY 2 - VATICAN

Breakfast, meet with the guide and visit of the Basilica of S. Peter, which with an area of 115 thousand square meters, is the largest in the world. Inside are preserved many masterpieces, among others the Pietà by Michelangelo and the bronze canopy by Gian Lorenzo Bernini. Visit to the crypt which preserves the remains of St. Peter, Pope John Paul II and numerous other popes. Finally, visit St. Peter's Square to admire its colonnade by Bernini.

Lunch free (not included)...

In the afternoon, visit to the Vatican Museums where various works spanning the ancient and contemporary ages are kept. Sarcophagi and mosaics share the space with masterpieces by great masters such as Giotto, Michelangelo, Leonardo Da Vinci, Raphael (here is the famous School of Athens) up to Dalì, Canova and Matisse. In the midst of so much beauty, the presence of a fragment of moon rock donated to Vatican citizens by former US president Nixon continues to amaze. The tour ends in the Sistine Chapel, a masterpiece by Michelangelo Buonarroti, where it is possible to admire the famous frescoes of the representation of the Last Judgment. Dinner in a typical Roman restaurant, return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 3 - COLOSSEUM AND ROMAN FORUM

Breakfast and visit to the largest archaeological area in the world. The Colosseum or Flavian Amphitheater, whose construction was commissioned by two Emperors of the Flavia family: Vespasiano and his son Tito. The Colosseum was started in 72 and finished in 80 A.D. Opposite stands the Arch of Constantine (4th century A.D.) then the Arch of Titus (1st century A.D.), continuing on we can admire the Forum with all its history and after we go up to the Capitol. On the famous hill, where the Municipality of Rome is based, we can admire the beautiful square in the shape of a trapezoid designed by Michelangelo. A visit to the Ara Coeli Church is not to be missed. On the other side of the hill is Piazza Venezia, home to the largest monument in Europe: the Monument to the Unknown Soldier, also known as the Vittoriano. Afternoon at leisure or visit to the Capitoline Museums. Return to the hotel, overnight.

DAY 4 - SPELLO AND ASSISI

Breakfast and transfer from Rome to Spello, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy. The city has been able to preserve a strong medieval atmosphere with its walls, its alleys and its works, such as the splendid frescoes by Pinturicchio preserved in the church of Santa Maria Maggiore.

Lunch free (not included).

In the afternoon departure for Assisi, known for being the birthplace of Saint Francis of Assisi and Saint Clare. We will visit the Basilica of St. Francis, the Rocca Maggiore, the Town Hall, the numerous churches and the Porziuncola in Santa Maria degli Angeli. The city as a whole transmits strong emotions for its mysticism and for the medieval atmosphere that you breathe there.

Arrival at the hotel, dinner and overnight.

Optional: lunch in a restaurant with typical Umbrian cuisine based on local black truffles.

DAY 5 - CORTONA AND FLORENCE

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Cortona, a city of Etruscan origin, of which there are many testimonies including the mighty walls dating back to the 4th century B.C. Possibility of visiting the Etruscan Museum where, among the treasures on display, we find the famous Tabula Cortonensis, a bronze sheet with one of the longest inscriptions in the Etruscan language. Lunch free (not included).

In the afternoon, transfer to Florence. Arrival at the hotel, overnight.



DAY 6 - FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel and meet with the guide. We will begin the visit from Piazza Santa Croce and its homonymous church in which the remains of Michelangelo Buonarroti, Galileo Galilei and Niccolò Machiavelli are kept. We will continue to Piazza della Signoria which is the heart of the Florence Museum with its sixteenth-century statues including Benvenuto Cellini's Perseus, Giambologna's Rape of the Sabines and Michelangelo's David. Then we will enter Piazza della Repubblica, an ancient Roman Forum, to end in Santa Maria in Fiore where the majestic Cathedral is located with Giotto's Bell Tower and the Baptistery next to it (entrance with ticket and skip the line). Afternoon at leisure for independent visits.

Optional activities: Visit to the Uffizi Museum, Dinner in a typical Tuscan restaurant. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 7 - PISA - SAN GIMIGNANO - MONTERIGGIONI

In the morning, after breakfast at the hotel, meet with the guide. Transfer to Pisa where we will visit the Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta, the iconic Leaning Tower, the Baptistery of San Giovanni and the Monumental Cemetery. Transfer to San Gimignano, the city of the Towers where we can find one of the best ice creams in the world. We will stroll through Piazza della Cisterna, Piazza Duomo and the buildings that surround it.

Lunch free (not included), we then continue to the nearby Monteriggioni, a defensive fortress of the Republic of Siena, which still retains a large part of the 13th century walls. Return to our hotel in Florence, dinner and overnight.

Optional activities: entrance to the Tower of Pisa, visit of the Baptistery of Pisa in Piazza dei Miracoli, Tasting of the famous Vernaccia wine of San Gimignano.

DAY 8 - END OF THE TOUR

Breakfast, check-out and end of the tour with transfer to the train station or Bologna airport.






