

A full itinerary to visit the renowned wine regions of Langhe, Valpolicella and Asti, known for producing world-class wines like Barolo and Amarone. Indulge in wine tastings, savor delicious meals, and explore the cultural treasures of Verona, Turin, Florence, and Rome.

#### Day 1: Start of the tour

Arrival in Milan and transfer to the hotel in Verona. Accommodation in a 4\* hotel in the city center, free time for lunch and meeting with the guide for a walking tour of Verona. We'll wander through the corridors of the **Roman Arena**, explore the allure of **Juliet's balcony** and stroll through he vibrant **Piazza delle Erbe**. Return to the hotel, free time for dinner and overnight stay.



#### Day 2: Walking tour of Valpolicella area

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to a **winery**. During our guided tour, we'll have the opportunity to appreciate prestigious red wines such as **Valpolicella**, **Valpolicella Superiore**, **Ripasso**, **and Amarone**. Additionally, a lunch will be served featuring platters of local products, produced by the company. Return to Verona, free time for dinner and individual visits and overnight stay.

#### Day 3: Sirmione and Borghetto

Breakfast at the hotel followed by a transfer to Sirmione. Meeting with the guide for a walking tour of **Sirmione** where we'll visit the splendid **Scaligero Castle** and explore the **Grottoes of Catullus**.

Transfer to **Borghetto di Valeggio sul Mincio** where we'll enjoy some free time for lunch followed by a walking tour of the center admiring the picturesque village of mills surrounded by medieval fortifications. Return to Verona, free time for individual visits and overnight stay.

#### Day 4: Walking tour of Turin

Breakfast, check-out, and transfer to **Turin.** With our guide we'll enjoy a welcome walk in the city center with an **aperitif** along the river. Free time for dinner and evening visits and overnight stay.



#### Day 5: Asti, Neive and Barolo

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to **Langhe Area** for a daily excursion. Meeting with the guide and start of the tour from **Asti**, renowned for its Spumante and Barbera wines, we'll explore its historic center including **Piazza Campo del Palio**, **Piazza Alfieri** and the exterior of **Palazzo Alfieri**.

Following that, we'll enjoy a private transfer to **Neive** for a visit to its historical city center. From **Piazza Italia**, we'll marvel at stunning views of the Langhe.
