# MALTA

## Between Fortified Cities, Sea and Millennia of History

Malta takes you to the heart of the Mediterranean, among the elegant Baroque architecture of Valletta, the ancient city of Mdina and the fishing villages overlooking crystal-clear waters. You will visit the charming Three Cities on the Grand Harbour and the authentic island of Gozo, with its ancient temples and spectacular landscapes, on an unforgettable journey.

### Day 1: Arrival in Malta

Arrival at Malta Airport and meeting with the local driver. Transfer by coach to the heart of the capital, **Valletta**, with luggage stored on board the bus.

In the afternoon, guided tour of **the fortified city**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the historical heart of the island. We begin with **St John's Co-Cathedral** (entrance included), renowned for its magnificent Baroque interiors, inlaid marble floors and Caravaggio's masterpiece. The tour continues along the elegant streets of the capital to the **Upper Barrakka Gardens**, a stunning panoramic terrace overlooking the Grand Harbour and the Three Cities. Walk along the historic bastions and enjoy one of the most breathtaking views in the Mediterranean.

At the end of the visit, transfer to a 3\* hotel in Sliema or St Julian's. Dinner and overnight stay.

### Day 2: Excursion to Gozo

After breakfast, departure for the port and ferry crossing to **Gozo**, the most authentic and green island of the Maltese archipelago.

Upon arrival, meet the local coach and begin the guided tour. The first stop will be the **Ġgantija Megalithic Temples**, among the oldest prehistoric monuments in the world, dating back over 5,000 years. Continue to the **Basilica of Ta' Pinu**, an important pilgrimage site, and then to Victoria, the island's capital, where free time will be available for lunch and a walk through the historic center.

In the afternoon, visit the picturesque **Wied il-Ghasri Bay**, set between high cliffs and crystal-clear waters, followed by the traditional salt pans, a fascinating example of ancient salt-harvesting techniques.

Return ferry to Malta, transfer to the hotel, dinner and overnight stay.



## Day 3: Mdina & Marsaxlokk

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for **Mdina**, the ancient capital known as the "Silent City." Walking through its narrow medieval streets and noble palaces, you will experience a timeless atmosphere. Continue to **Rabat**, where you can admire from the outside the main historical sites, including **St Paul's Catacombs**. Free time for lunch.

In the afternoon, panoramic stop at the **Dingli Cliffs**, the highest point of the island, offering spectacular views over the open sea. Continue to the picturesque fishing village of **Marsaxlokk**, famous for its natural harbor and colorful traditional luzzu boats. Free time to stroll along the waterfront or relax in one of the seaside restaurants.

Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight stay.



## Day 4: Departure

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer to **Valletta** and ferry crossing across the Grand Harbour to Vittoriosa. Upon arrival, guided visit of the Three Cities: **Vittoriosa**, **Senglea** and **Cospicua**, the historic heart of the Knights of St John era. Walking through bastions, narrow streets and historic palaces, you will discover stories of sieges and daily Maltese life through the centuries.

At the end of the visit, transfer to the airport in time for the return flight.
